



Coworking has exploded with growth nearly doubling each year since 2005; making coworking the fastest growing work trend this decade.

According to global research by Deskmag, since working in a coworking space:

74%

of coworkers are more productive

93% have a bigger social network

64% of coworkers are better able to complete tasks on time

60% said they were more relaxed at home since coworking

90% of people said they felt more confident when coworking

86% reported having a larger business network

Since working in a coworking space, more than **two-thirds** feel more creative and collaborate more on projects; **one-third** reported an increase in income.

“Coworking hinges on the belief that innovation and inspiration come from cross pollination of different people in different fields or specializations.
